



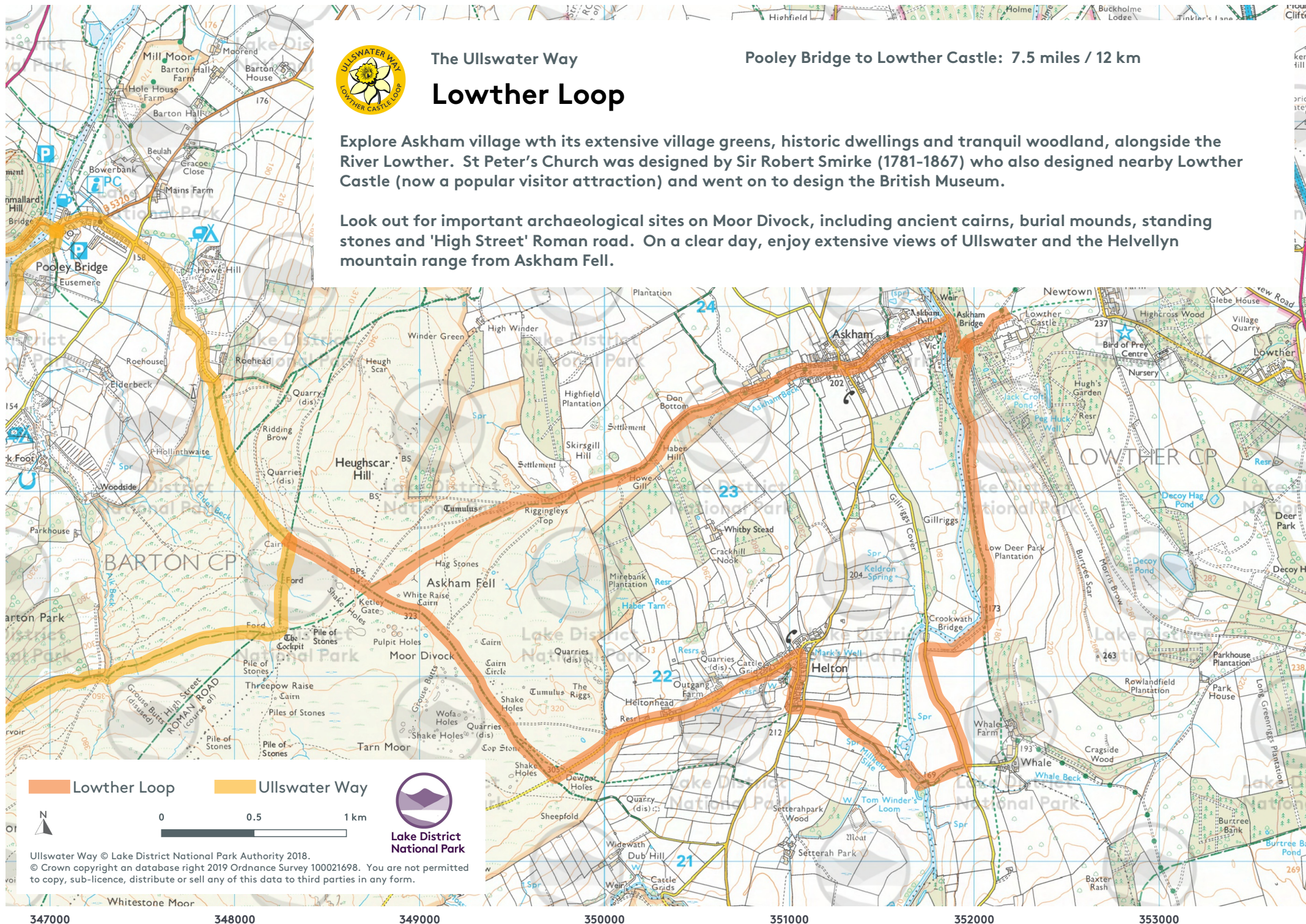

## Lowther Loop

Pooley Bridge to Lowther Castle: 7.5 miles / 12 km

Explore Askham village with its extensive village greens, historic dwellings and tranquil woodland, alongside the River Lowther. St Peter's Church was designed by Sir Robert Smirke (1781-1867) who also designed nearby Lowther Castle (now a popular visitor attraction) and went on to design the British Museum.

Look out for important archaeological sites on Moor Divock, including ancient cairns, burial mounds, standing stones and 'High Street' Roman road. On a clear day, enjoy extensive views of Ullswater and the Helvellyn mountain range from Askham Fell.
